1. **LAUNDRY AND CLEANING:** For the information and compliance of all concerned, Section II, Circular 37, Hq ETUSA, dated 9 April 1944, is quoted:

"PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS FOR LAUNDRY AND CLEANING. 1. Effective with the payrolls covering April, 1944, all enlisted personnel receiving laundry and/or dry-cleaning service will be charged therefor at the monthly rates of \$1.00 for laundry and 35¢ for cleaning.

2. These charges will be accomplished in accordance with Par 1d, AR 35-2440. When services are furnished, there will be entered on the payroll, following the name of each enlisted man: 'Due for laundry and/or dry-cleaning, \$ \_\_\_\_\_. Credit: GPR-MR215215 Laundry and Dry Cleaning Operations'.

3. Nothing herein shall be deemed to alter in any way the existing arrangements as to the supply of laundry and dry-cleaning service, the size and composition of authorized laundry bundles, and the physical handling of clothing for laundry and cleaning.

2. **CURFEW:** It is deemed expedient that all enlisted personnel be made aware of the facts that curfew hour in Norwich is 2300, and for the base, 2400 hours. All sectional and Unit Commanders will adequately publicize the foregoing, and will be responsible for their command's knowledge, comprehension, and compliance with its provisions.
3. **AWARDS AND DECORATIONS:** In order to comply with regulations regarding awards, it will be necessary for each officer who has, to date, been decorated by the government, to report to the Base Statistical Officer, Station Headquarters, prior to 25 April 1944, with a copy of his orders.
