
1. WAR BALLOTS: (1) In accordance with the provisions of par 2, Circular 33, HQ STOUS, 21 Dec 1944, official ballots cast by members of the armed forces and civilians under military jurisdiction are classified as official mail and will not be opened or subjected to any type of unit or base censorship.
(2) Pending distribution of distinctively marked cards and envelopes, all military personnel and attached civilians have been instructed to write in the upper right corner of their ballot envelopes or application cards (WD AGO Form 560) the words: "Free of Postage including Air Mail (War Ballot)" and immediately above the first line of the address, the words: "Official Election War Ballot via Air Mail."
(3) Personnel of the following organizations are authorized free air mail service for ballots and applications for same: a) Military and Naval Forces; b) Merchant Marine; c) American Red Cross; d) Society of Friends; e) United Service Organizations and f) Women's Auxiliary Service Pilots.
(4) No provisions are made for free special delivery service or free registration of ballots. When such services are required by State law, the regular fee must be paid by the sender.
