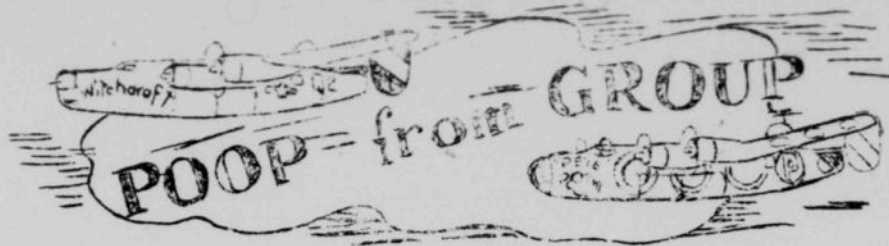

ACCIDENT CAUSES: HUMAN AND MECHANICAL; YOU CONTROL BOTH

1. GROUND SAFETY CONTEST: 1. A Ground Safety Contest will be conducted on this station under the supervision of the Station Ground Safety Officer. This contest is designed to increase personal "safety consciousness" through the submission of Safety Posters and Safety Slogans.

2. Rules governing the contest are as follows:

a. Posters:

- (1) Poster subject will be the prevention of accidents.
- (2) Posters may be pencil drawings, paintings, or arrangements of photographs.
- (3) Posters will not exceed 21 inches by 26 inches in size.
- (4) First and second prize winners of Station Ground Safety Poster contest will be forwarded to Division Headquarters. Name, rank, ASN, and station of person submitting entries must appear on reverse side of entry.

b. Slogans:

- (1) Slogans will contain those concerned with prevention of accidents.
- (2) First and second prize winners of Station Ground Safety Slogan contest will be forwarded to Division Headquarters. Name, rank, ASN, and station of person submitting entries must appear on reverse side of entry.

3. Prizes to be awarded:

- a. Winning Safety Poster 48-hour pass to Paris
- b. Winning Safety Slogan 48-hour pass to Paris
- c. Additional prizes may be arranged for and awarded at the discretion of the Station Ground Safety Officer.

4. Final decision as to awardees will be determined by the Division Ground Safety Council.

5. All entries must be submitted to this Headquarters by 1700 hours, 28 April 1945.
