

- TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS FOR WHITEH: (a) PASSES, involving travel by rail for a distance in excess of 20 miles, will not be granted between 16 May 1945 and 22 May 1945, both dates inclusive. (b) LEAVES and FURLOUGHS, involving travel by rail for a distance in excess of 20 miles, will not be granted between 16 May 1945 and 22 May 1945, both dates inclusive. (c) Exceptions to these instructions will be made only in the following case: (1) Personnel on leave or furlough for the express purpose of attending university course offered by the Information and Education office of this Headquarters. (d) Commanding Officers of personnel indicated in paragraph c1 above, will indorse and sign leave or furlough papers of such personnel in red to read: "Authorized to travel by Rail." The foregoing restrictions do not apply to flying personnel.
- OFFICERS' TRAVELING PX: The Officers' Traveling PX will be on this Station the 17th and 18th of May. It will be open between the hours of 0900 & 1700.
- OFFICERS' DANCE: There will be an Officers' Dance at the Officers' Club on Saturday, 19 May 1945.
- EM BARBER SHOP: The EM Barber Shop will be open daily, except Sundays, from 1100 hours to 2000 hours.
- ALLOTMENTS AND BONDS: Any officers or enlisted men desiring to make changes in allotments or bonds should accomplish this prior to 25 May 1945.
